About the California State University Placement Tests

Start smart at California State University (CSU)

CSU requires you to take the English Placement Test (EPT) and the Entry-Level Mathematics Test (ELM) before you enroll. Your scores will determine which math and English courses you should take to begin your career at CSU.

Relax!

The EPT and the ELM are not admission tests. They will not affect your admission to any CSU campus — they simply help determine which courses best match your level of performance in math and English.

Please Note: As of January 2, 2012, students will [register for the EPT and ELM at any CSU campus online here](#). If you plan to test before February 11, 2012, registration will be handled by the individual [CSU campuses](#).

Who Takes the Test? Who Doesn't?

Most of you will have to take the exam, but there are some circumstances under which you may be exempt. For example, if you have performed well on another standardized test, such as the SAT®, or earned transferable credits from another college, you may not need to take one or both of the exams.

Who should take the test

The California State University (CSU) requires you to take the English Placement Test (EPT) and the Entry Level Mathematics (ELM) exam prior to enrollment in the CSU. Your scores will determine which Math and English courses you should take to begin your career at CSU. You may be exempt from taking the EPT or ELM based on your scores earned on other appropriate tests such as the CSU's Early Assessment Program (EAP) tests in English and Mathematics, the SAT®, ACT®, or Advanced Placement® (AP). This site will determine if you are exempt as part of the registration process. For more information about the EPT and ELM click on the EPT/ELM Information Bulletin link below.

Students with Disabilities, needing special accommodations or those unable to test on a Saturday due to religious beliefs must contact the CSU Campus where they plan to test at prior to registration. You will need to provide documentation to the campus in order to receive special accommodations or an alternative test date.
