Assembly Bills AB130 & AB131 allow AB540 students to apply for privately funded scholarships and institutional grants.



To qualify students must:

- Have attended a CA high school for at least 3 years.
- Have graduated from a CA high school or have attained the equivalent of a high school diploma.
- Have registered or currently be enrolled at a CA public college/university.
- Not be a non-immigrant holding a valid lettered non-immigrant visa.**
- File a CA Non-Resident Tuition Waiver with the Office of Admissions and Outreach.

AB130 effective 1/1/2012

Sac State students who meet above criteria have become eligible for private scholarships. Please visit: <http://csus.edu/faid/scholarships>

AB131 effective 1/1/2013

Sac State students who meet above criteria may now be eligible for Institutional Grants and State Grant funding.

****Non-immigrant students are not eligible for this exemption**

Non-immigrant students, as defined by federal immigration law, may hold one of the following visas: A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, U, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, TN, TD, V TROV, and NATO.
